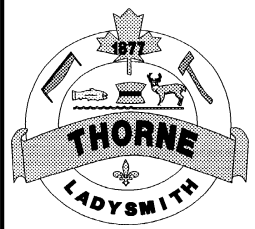

**CHOCOLATE RICE KRISPIE BALLS**

1/2 cup peanut butter  
3 T soft butter  
1 tsp vanilla  
1 cup Rice Krispies  
1/2 cup chopped pecans  
1 cup shredded coconut

Mix together, refrigerate for half hour and then form into balls. Return to fridge and let chill at least an hour.


Melt the following together in a double boiler:

1 package chocolate chips  
1 square sweet chocolate

Keep on low so chocolate remains soft. Drop balls into chocolate mixture one at a time using a fork to roll them so that the chocolate will cover. Let set on parchment paper in fridge.

### CAULIFLOWER SOUP

- 1 medium head cauliflower, broken into florets
- 1 medium carrot, shredded
- 1/4 cup chopped celery
- 2 1/2 cups water
- 1 chicken or vegetable bouillon cube
- 3 T butter
- 3 T flour
- 3/4 tsp salt and a pinch of pepper
- 2 cups milk
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1/2 to 1 tsp hot sauce, optional

Combine in a saucepan, cauliflower, carrot, celery, water and bouillon. Bring to a boil, reduce heat, cover and simmer 12-15 minutes or until vegetables are tender. Do not drain. In another saucepan, melt butter. Stir in flour, salt and pepper until smooth. Gradually add milk. Bring to a boil over medium heat, cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Reduce heat, stir in the cheese until melted. Add hot sauce if desired. Stir into the vegetable mixture.

Yield: About 2 quarts or 8 servings.
