Chrissy Schwerdtfeger from Otter Lake was thrilled to receive her "50" small cars.

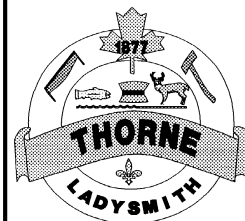
The first flea market of the summer was very well attended and continues every Saturday from 9 a.m to 2 p.m. Last sale is August 19.
