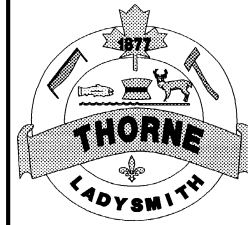

TURKEY CAKES


- 2 cups ground cooked turkey
- 1 T finely grated onion
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 tsp salt (or to taste)
- 2 1/2 cups leftover mashed potatoes
- 1/4 cup chopped parsley
- 1 egg, slightly beaten
- 1/4 tsp pepper
- Flour & margarine

Combine the turkey, potatoes, onion, parsley, milk, egg, salt & pepper, mixing slightly with a fork. Shape into 8 cakes about 1" thick. Dip cakes in flour to coat both sides and fry in margarine until golden brown on both sides, about 5 minutes a side. Good served in or with hot toasted buns and a side salad.

PINEAPPLE ANGEL FOOD CAKE

- 1 box of angel food cake mix
 - 1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple
 - *the standard Canadian 19 ounce works*
 - *do not drain pineapple*
- Preheat oven to 350°
Grease a 9x13 baking dish.
In a large bowl, mix together the angel food cake mix and the crushed pineapple and stir until well combined.

Pour the batter into the pan and bake for about 30 minutes or until done.
To avoid the cake falling a bit in the middle, you can immediately turn cake upside down to cool. (Support on edges of two loaf pans.)
Simple, easy and pineapple-y.
Serve this amazing cake with cool whip or ice cream on top.
