ON THE OCCASION OF THE NOVEMBER 7, 2021, ELECTION, the municipal council of THORNE

decided to offer electors who will be 70 years of age or older on polling day the possibility of voting by mail.



If you meet this condition and would like to vote by mail, you must apply **on or before Wednesday, October 27, 2021.**



Completed ballot papers must be received at the returning officer's polling station **on or before Friday, November 5, 2021, at 4:30 p.m.**

If you are eligible for voting by mail, you can also seek a change to the list of electors in writing.

Twice as large and four times as heavy as its cousin the martin, the fisher cat is a member of the weasel family. The fisher can be identified by its dark black/brown coat and a lighter cream coloured bib on the chest.

A devout carnivore and exceptional predator, the fisher is one of the few predators of the porcupine! Mice, chipmunks, sqirrel, and rabbit make up the majority of their diet.

The fisher is only found in North America, from British Columbia all the way to the Maritimes. In terms of habitat, the fisher will only establish a permanent den when raising their young. When not caring for the kits the fisher will find shelter in logs, hollow trees, stumps and the abandoned dens of ground dwelling animals.

Seafood Chowder



2 Tbsp unsalted butter
 1 stalk celery, minced
 1 small onion, minced
 1/4 tsp cayenne
 1/4 tsp thyme
 3 Tbsp flour

2-1/2C milk - 2%
 2C vegetable soup stock
 2 cans condensed cream of celery soup
 2 white potatoes, cubed
 2 lb seafood, cooked
 salt and pepper to taste
 parsley or green onions, for garnish

- In a large soup pot, saute celery and onions in melted butter approximately 5 minutes.
- Add 1C soup stock and potatoes, thyme, cayenne, salt and pepper. Simmer 10 minutes or until potatoes are almost fork tender. Add flour, whisk well.
- Mix milk and cream of celery into pot. Add seafood. Simmer 15-20 minutes.
- Garnish with parsley or green onions if desired.

Note: do not allow the soup to boil once the milk is added or else the chowder will curdle! yuck.

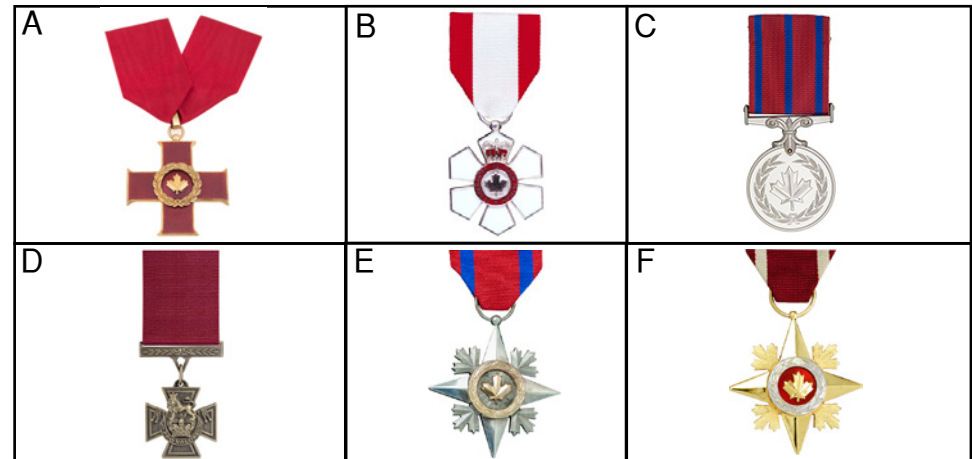
